Dear Parents/Carers

Inter-Schools Cross Country at Haddenham Junior School - 4/02/12

Firstly, I would like to say a huge well done to all of those who ran on Saturday 21st at TJS - the children all gave it their best and I am proud of every single one of them for turning out to represent our school. We had double the number of children there than most of the other schools which is fantastic!

The next race is only two weeks away as this is such a short half term! It is to be held at Haddenham Junior School on Saturday 4th February. This event will take place on a Saturday. If your child wishes to take part they are most welcome!

The children thoroughly enjoy participating in these events and after an excellent start to the season I hope we can continue to have just as many children running! In addition to the obvious health benefits; they gain points for their school team and medals are awarded to the first three runners in each race. Every child that enters will receive a merit certificate from the school as recognition of their efforts.

The races run at the following times and you are asked to arrive at least 20 minutes prior to your child's race to allow them to warm up.

The events are expected to finish by 11.45am. In the event that the times change I will let you know asap.

Due to the costs of staging the event an entry fee of £2.00 per runner is required.

If your child is able to participate in the event on Saturday 4th February could you please sign the form below and return it to school.

You will need to ensure your child has a red school PE t-shirt to race in as well as warm clothing, such as a track suit. It is also vital that your child has appropriate trainers/spikes, we strongly advise that children do not wear indoor plimsolls, as they will be unsuitable for the course.

In preparation for this race I will be running extra practices for those who want to take part at lunchtimes (except Weds where the practice is after school). Ideally those who want to race should try to come to at least two of these extra practices if they can. I do however understand that some children have other commitments at lunchtimes.

We are looking forward to seeing as many children as possible at these events.
